Gulf State Park Recreation & Activities

- 28 miles of hiking and biking trails
- · 800 acres of freshwater fishing lakes
- Nature Center: a living museum of plants and animals that are native to the Gulf Coast region. Our weekly programs include guided nature walks, beach walks, pier walks, and nature time. Through these educational programs, we offer a multitude of learning opportunities for children and adults about Alabama's Gulf Coast.
- Gulf State Park Fishing & Education Pier: the largest pier on the Gulf of Mexico, stretching a quarter mile into the Gulf, offers plenty of fishing and sightseeing action 24 hours a day, all year. Guided pier walks offer the history of the Pier, fun facts about some of the wildlife to be seen, and the opportunity to observe the day's catch. Want to try your hand? Equipment and bait are available. Fees and licenses are required for fishing. Overnight park guests may sightsee

Our Story



Nature Center


