#### THURSDAY, March 9

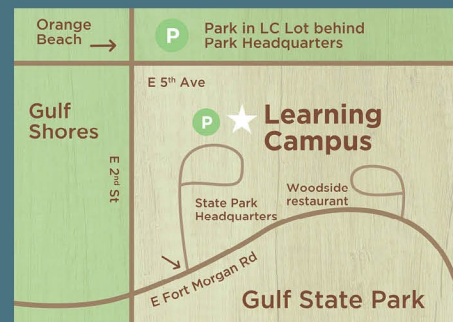
