THURSDAY, May 18

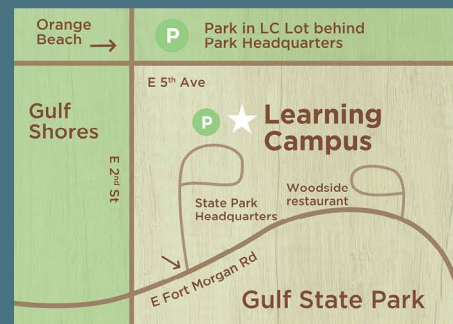
